Major Salis served with the Cape Mounted Riflemen throughout the Kaffir war of 1840-47; against the insurgent Boers at Boem Plaats in 1848 where he was dangerously wounded, and had his horse killed under him; also in the Kaffir war of 1850-53 (Medal); and when in command of a detachment at Graham's Town he quelled a serious mutiny of the Native soldiers; served in the Crimea from Feb 1855 (Medal and Clasp for Sebastopol). During a period of 13 years service abroad he was in nineteen actions and skirmishes and was frequently mentioned in public orders for gallant and skilful conduct. [Hart's Army List].¹

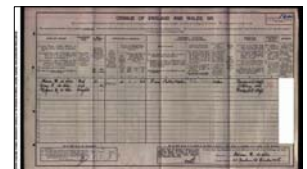
